### CHRISTMAS PARTIES



## LIBERTIES

22 OCT – 7 JAN 2017

*Liberties*, with works by 24 women artists, presents a snapshot of the evolving conversations that contribute to the mapping of a woman's place in British society, through film, photography, sculpture, performance and painting.

The exhibition reflects the changes in art practice over the past 40 years since the introduction of the Sex Discrimination Act in the UK. Some artists confront issues that galvanised the change in law whilst others carved their own place in a complex and male dominated art world. From the radical movements of the 1960s and 70s to the


