FACING THE SUN

An immersive installation of new paintings, clay and fabric works

Kitty Hillier's work is rooted in what's above and below the surface, with a belief that all things are connected. Her paintings and groupings of objects comprise layers of overlapping biomorphic shapes distilled from everyday details, made with a diverse range of materials and often painstaking processes of hand-construction that reflect patterns found in nature and the slow formation of structures over time. With her recent research continuing to circulate around the divided human brain, plant intelligence and the idea that abstraction can help us to see the bigger picture, Kitty is using her time in The Picture Room to experiment with creating a multisensory experience that sparks curiosity in the living earth, particularly what is unseen and inaudible.

Occupying a cave-like space is a collection of new soft sculptures, suspended or slumped, while clay vessels hold pools of water or invite deep listening. The exhibition title 'Facing the Sun' suggests a cautiously optimistic outlook — a vision of a future which values creativity, symbiosis and gut intuition, where a deep awareness of our interdependence with the minutiae prevails. There are also maquette's for large-scale interactive structures yet to be realised, and playful abstract studies like mini portals that explore colour, edges and seem to hold within them a delicate balance of control and chance encounters.
