

# YOUNG PEOPLE'S ART PRIZE 2019 GUIDELINES

- Entries are welcome from all young people living in Cornwall aged 11 - 19 years inclusive
- Each entrant may submit **one** piece of work
- Each work must have the submission form firmly attached
- Unframed work is preferred
- Deadline for entries is **Mon 18 Mar**
- All entries should be delivered to The Exchange, Princes Street, Penzance before 17.00 on Mon 18 Mar, unless otherwise agreed with The Exchange
- Judging will take place on Tue 19 Mar
- **All schools or groups wishing to use the *woman-with-a-van collection service* must register their request with The Exchange by Mon 11 Mar**

## THE PROCEDURE:

- Upon arrival the work will be divided into three age categories:  
11 - 13 yrs, 14 - 16 yrs, 17 - 19 yrs
- The work entered will be subject to two stages: shortlisting for exhibition by the judges, and subsequent judging of winners from the selected exhibition
- There will be one judge from The Exchange and up to three external artists
- Shortlisted artists will be notified by Wed 20 Mar
- Shortlisted work will be available for viewing by the public Thu 21 Mar – Sat 27 Apr

THU 21 MAR AT 18.00 IN THE ENGINE ROOM AT THE EXCHANGE

- Work being returned by *woman-with-a-van service* will be delivered to schools and colleges on Tue 30 Apr [tbc]
- All other work to be collected between Mon 29 Apr and Fri 3 May

- Please do make sure that each piece of work has the submission form firmly attached
- Each entry must be exhibited for the entire length of the *Young People's Art Prize 2019* exhibition
