### CARE TAKERS

A new series of work by Hannah Waldron, an artist working predominantly with weaving, from her studio at Potager, near Constantine.



### CARE TAKERS

From top left:

Care Taker 1 - Handweaving using wool, silk and linen yarn dyed with madder, weld, chilli and indigo. (spider on sun)

Care Taker 2 - Handweaving using bamboo, wool, silk and linen yarn dyed with madder, woad and indigo. (stacked shapes)

Care Taker 3 - Handweaving with embroidery, using bamboo, silk and linen yarn dyed with woad, weld, chilli and indigo. (diamond cell with yellow oval)

Care Taker 4 - Handweaving using bamboo, wool, silk and linen yarn dyed with woad, weld, madder, chilli and indigo. (four strung shapes)

Care Taker 5 - Handweaving using bamboo, silk and linen yarn dyed with woad, and indigo. (white stacked shapes)

Care Taker 6 - Handweaving with embroidery, using wool, silk and linen yarn dyed with madder, weld, and indigo. (two white semi circles with sun spiral bottom right)

Care Taker 7 - Handweaving with embroidery, using wool, silk and linen yarn dyed with madder, weld, and indigo. (pink oval white rectangle)

Care Taker 8 - Handweaving with embroidery, using wool, silk and linen yarn dyed with madder, weld, and indigo. (3 pink semi circles)

Care Taker 9 - Handweaving using wool, silk and linen yarn dyed with madder, weld, and indigo. (5 pointed white cell with yellow oval)

Care Taker 10 - Handweaving with embroidery, using wool, bamboo, silk and linen yarn dyed with woad, and indigo. (oval blob trees with underground network)

Care Taker 11 - Handweaving using wool, bamboo, silk and linen yarn dyed with woad, madder, chilli and indigo. (white cells on pink background)

Care Taker 12 - Handweaving with embroidery, using bamboo, silk and linen yarn dyed with woad, weld, and indigo. (large spider on sun)

Care Taker 13 - Handweaving with embroidery, using silk and linen yarn dyed with indigo. (spider in web)

Care Taker 14 - Handweaving using wool, silk and linen yarn dyed with madder, weld, and indigo. (4 pink semi circles with sun and spider)

Care Taker 15 - Handweaving with embroidery, using wool, silk and linen yarn dyed with madder and indigo. (pink egg in web)

Care Taker 16 - Handweaving with embroidery, using wool, silk and linen yarn dyed with indigo. (baby growing on plant)

All weavings are roughly 190 x 250mm, mounted on natural linen, framed with barefaced lime mouldings.

All are £330 framed

## STILL LIVES



From top left:

Still Lives 1 - Handweaving with embroidery using wool, silk and linen yarn dyed with madder, weld, chilli and indigo. (white square with dot)

Still Lives 2 - Handweaving with embroidery using wool, silk and linen yarn dyed with madder, woad and indigo. (Stripey flower)

Still Lives 3 - Handweaving, using bamboo, wool, silk and linen yarn dyed with woad, weld, madder, chilli and indigo. (winding path with leaf and bud)

Still Lives 4 - Handweaving using bamboo, wool, silk and linen yarn dyed with woad, weld, madder, and chilli. (Petals with squares)

Still Lives 5 - Handweaving with embroidery using wool, silk and linen yarn dyed with madder, weld, and indigo. (dandelion stem)

Still Lives 6 - Handweaving, using bamboo, wool, silk and linen yarn dyed with madder, weld, woad and indigo. (drooping daisy stem)

Still Lives 7 - Handweaving with embroidery, using wool, silk and linen yarn dyed with madder, weld, and indigo. (forget-me-not and daisy)

Still Lives 8 - Handweaving, using wool, bamboo, silk and linen yarn dyed with madder, weld, woad and indigo. (yellow crescent moon)

Still Lives 9 - Handweaving using bamboo, silk and linen yarn dyed with woad weld, and indigo. (daisy burst)

Still Lives 10 - Handweaving with embroidery, using bamboo, silk, wool and linen yarn dyed with woad, weld, chilli and indigo. (white square with large blue leaf)

Still Lives 11 - Handweaving with embroidery using bamboo, wool, silk and linen yarn dyed with weld, madder, and indigo. (yellow circle and 3 white leaves)

Still Lives 12 - Handweaving, using bamboo, silk, wool and linen yarn dyed with woad, madder, chilli, weld and indigo. (cube and dropped petal)

All weavings are roughly 120 x 150mm, mounted on natural linen, framed with barefaced lime mouldings.

All are £295 framed

#### OTHER WEAVINGS

Network 1 - Handweaving with embroidery using silk and linen yarn dyed with madder, weld, and indigo. (web with moon and circle)

Network 2- Handweaving with embroidery using wool, silk and linen yarn dyed with madder, weld and indigo. (yellow center on pink)

Network 3 - Handweaving, using silk and linen yarn dyed with indigo. (rectangular web)

All weavings are roughly 297 x 210mm, mounted on natural linen, framed with barefaced lime mouldings.

All are £375 framed

#### LARGE WEAVING

Net Work - 150 cm x 110 cm roughly, hanging on wooden bar.  
Linen, bamboo, wool, and cotton madder, woad, indigo and weld natural dyes.
